DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Copper sulphides occur in northwest trending shear zones in granodiorite of the Hogem batholith.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located south of the east end of Tchentlo Lake.

The R.T. and S.K. groups, totalling 76 claims, were reportedly held during the period 1967-1969 by West Coast Mining and Exploration; there is no record of this company as a Canadian incorporation. Work during 1967 included geophysical and geochemical surveys, and 2,000 feet of diamond drilling in 6 holes.

In 1971 the S.K. and other groups, totalling about 280 claims, were held as the Night Hawk group by Boronda Mining Corporation Ltd., of Los Angeles. Work in 1970 and 1971 included geological, electromagnetic, induced potential, magnetometer, and geochemical surveys.
