DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite occurs in a volcanic sequence near the contact of syenite, with K-feldspar, silica, epidote, and chlorite alteration.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 feet elevation 3 miles north of the mid section of Chuchi Lake.

The SRM 1-20, 25-66, and CIR 1-20 claims were held in 1971 by S.E.R.E.M. Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of SEREM Ltee, of Paris, which is owned by the French government. Work during the year included geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey, a magnetometer survey over 23.4 line-miles, and trenching on SRM 9 and 11 claims. Further work during 1973 included a geochemical survey comprising 345 soil and 17 silt samples over 19.8 line-miles.
