DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Volcanic rocks of andesite composition belonging to the Upper Triassic and Jurassic Takla group show at this point a few seams of chalcopyrite 2 or 3 inches in width, and some narrow seams of calcite. Selected portions of the chalcopyrite assayed: gold, trace; silver, 0.16 ounce a ton; copper, 10.6%. Just south of the showings a belt of granite is exposed on both sides of the Arm.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This occurrence is located just above lake shore on the Northwest Arm of Takla Lake, some 66 miles east of Hazelton. Just south of the showings a belt of granite is exposed on both sides of the Arm.
