DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite occurs as coatings on widely spaced fractures in country rocks which include hornblendite and diorite phases of the Hogem batholith. These have been intruded by granodiorite-quartz monzonite bodies.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located approximately 4 miles northeast of the west end of Tchentlo Lake.

The Tyger 1-70, 121-150 claims were held in 1973 by Amoco Canada Petroleum Company Ltd. Work included geological mapping, ground magnetometer and geochemical soil surveys.
