DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Malachite and chalcopyrite with calcite and hematite occur in a pyritic breccia zone in andesitic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located 4 miles west of Klawli Lake, and 6 miles north of Tchentlo Lake.

The LUC 1-4 claims were owned in 1970 by Mr. John King. Work at that time included geological mapping, magnetometer and soil geochemical surveys. The claims subsequently lapsed.

The property was restaked by G.C. Gutrath as the CUL 1-30 claims, with CUL 15-18 covering the former LUC 1-4 claims. Calico Silver Mines Ltd. optioned the property in November 1971. The former soil geochemical survey grid was extended and filled in along selected lines with 88 more samples.
