DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite and pyrite mineralization occur in monzonite of the Hogen batholith and intermediate volcanic rocks of the Takla Group.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 feet elevation 5 miles north of Chuchi Lake.

The Dingle 1-26 claims were held in 1972 by Noranda Mines, Limited. Work included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 11.9 line-miles, and a geochemical soil survey (574 samples).
