Molybdenite occurs in fractures in augite porphyry of the Takla Group.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Ahdatay Creek 7 miles north of Tchentlo Lake.

The Sooner 1-36 and 1-16 Fractional claims were held during 1972-73 by Noranda Exploration Company, Limited. Work on the property included induced potential and resistivity surveys over 6.28 line-miles, a magnetometer survey, a reconnaissance geochemical soil survey, and 873 feet of diamond drilling in 4 holes on Sooner 16 and 27, and Sooner 14 Fr.
