DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT
At the showing a grey, rather fine-grained granodicrite
occurs on either side of an easterly depression. South of the
depression a white quartz vein is intermittently exposed for
about 100 feet and has a width in places exceeding 1 foot. The
vein, striking N80°E and dipping south, is crossed by numerous
steep, parallel fractures which contain small amounts of molybdenite. About 20 feet farther south is a second parallel quartz
vein. The granodicrite between the veins is traversed by quartz
veinlets one-quarter of an inch wide locally containing molybdenite in very small quantity. North of the depression, about
440 feet north-northwest of the veins, bouldery quartz vein
material contains abundant pyrite and conspicuous molybdenite as
scattered rosettes and fine aggregates either on or near fractures.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT The Blackjack eastern showing is on the divide between Manson River and Boulder Creek, about $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of Manson Creek settlement.

Forty-six claims covering the Blackjack showings were held in 1965 by Wm. Rigler and associates. In 1970 the A 1-16 and B 1-13 claims owned by Wm. Rigler and Robert Jackson were under option to Javelin Mines Ltd. Work during the year included geological and geochemical surveys and bulldozer trenching.
