DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Molybdenite occurs in a quartz porphyry sill intruding volcanic and sedimentary rocks of the Slide Mountain Group (Mississippian and/or Permian).

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at Reed Lake, 10 miles west of McLeod Lake, some 80 miles north of Prince George.

Iso Explorations Ltd. in 1971 held the Jack 1-36, Hart 1-12, Noni 3-9, 11, Don 1-10, and J 1-12 claims. Work during the year included a geochemical soil survey (2,000 samples), and 2,000 feet of diamond drilling in 7 holes on Jack 1 and 3. The drilling encountered narrow widths of mineralization.
