DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The principal showings involve medium to thick-bedded dolomite with argillaceous and sandy dolomite interbeds. The dolomite contains numerous brecciated horizons, some of them finely mineralized.

Associated minerals or products of value - Lead.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 5,000 foot elevation on a tributary of the Halfway River 6 miles northeast of Robb Lake.

The Ron 1-40 claims were held in 1973 by Buckhorn Mines Ltd. Work included geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey (716 samples), and diamond drilling in 4 holes totalling 815 feet on Ron 19 and 20.
