## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The most important showings are almost at water's edge on the south shore of Delkluz Lake. Here a thickness of about 25 feet of contorted and brecciated limestone of the Ingenika group has been replaced by quartz and siderite over an area 30 feet long by 20 feet wide. Discontinuous lenses, up to 3 feet thick, composed mainly of galena, sphalerite, and pyrite, occur in the upper part of the exposed section. Approximately 1,000 feet south of the main showings a small pocket of sphalerite and galena was found in a ground mass of calcite within brecciated limestone partly replaced by siderite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Onward group lies on the south side of Delkluz Lake, about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles due south of the Ferguson group. The property was owned by Ingenika Mines, Limited, and was explored at the same time as the Ferguson group. Stripping and trenching have failed to expose any significant extension of the deposit, nor has a total of 210 feet of underground workings, directly beneath the mineralized outcrop, revealed any significant indications of lead-zinc mineralization. Work on the second showing consisted of stripping and a 30 foot deep shaft.
