DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showing apparently consists of several outcrops of drusy quartz veins mineralized with pyrite and minor amounts of galena, sphalerite, and free gold. The surrounding region is underlain by micaceous quartzites and phyllites but the veins are reported to lie in dark green porphyritic andesite. The veins are reported to be as much as 4 feet wide. The claims also contain extensive outcrops of limonite-hematite gossan.

This showing is located at the 5,000 foot elevation on the west side of Conical Peak, about 2 miles south of the Ingenika River. The Ingenika group of 8 claims was staked on the showings by Gust Ola of Fort Grahame in 1947.
