HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 15 miles due north of Trident Peak, 130 miles west-northwest of Fort St. John.

The Pika 1-10, RL 7 and 8, and Mac 1-4 claims were held in 1972 by Buckhorn Mines Ltd. A geochemical soil survey (132 samples) was carried out over Pika 5 and 6.
