DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

In the area monzodiorite and diorite, which have been invaded by numerous dykes and apophyses of fine-grained quartz monzonite (plus monzonite), are in contact with Takla Group rocks. Chalcopyrite occurs as fracture coatings, coarse grains in quartz veins, and minor disseminations over the whole property. Mineralization includes chalcopyrite and specular hematite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 6,000 feet elevation at the head of Tenakihi Creek, 40 miles northwest of Germansen Landing.

The OY 1-40 and DUD 1-8 claims were held in 1973 by Amoco Canada Petroleum Company Ltd. Geological mapping and line-cutting was reported.
