DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by limestone and andesite of the Pennsylvanian (?) and Permian Cache Creek Group. Mineralization consists of sphalerite and galena.

Associated minerals or products of value - Lead.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,000 feet elevation 2 miles northeast of Wasi Lake.

Pechiney Development Limited held the Greg 1-6 and 11-14 claims in 1973. Geological mapping, a ground magnetometer survey over 6.5 line-miles, and a geochemical soil survey (307 samples) was carried out during the year. In 1974 the property included the OSS 1-11 claims. Trenching was carried out on Greg 5, 6, and 11.
