DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT A shear zone striking N50 W and dipping 85 NE cuts mediumgrained granodiorite of the Hogem batholith. Closely spaced fractures form a permeable, mineralized zone at least 120 feet wide. The fractured rock is sparsely but uniformly mineralized with pyrite, chalcopyrite, and bornite. The zone also contains 5 veins, 2 to 10 inches wide, that consist typically of coarse-grained crystalline pyrite at the center, flanked by mixed chalcopyrite and pyrite, which in turn merge into a quartz-epidote border zone. The granodiorite between the veins is much fractured; the fractures are filled with thin seams of malachite and azurite, and small grains of sulphide, thought to be in part chalcopyrite, are disseminated through the freshly broken rock. A grab sample of this material assayed: gold, trace; silver, 0.03 ounce a ton; and copper, 2.02%. A grab sample of nearly solid pyrite-chalcopyrite ore assayed: gold, 0.01 ounce a ton; silver, 1.31 ounces a ton; and copper 18.93%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Matetlo copper showing is exposed in the precipitous wall of the cirque at the head of the east branch of Matetlo Creek, some 45 miles southwest of Fort Grahame.

The Kam 1-36 claims were staked on the showings in October 1970 by Peter Dunsford. There was evidence of previous staking and limited packsack diamond drilling. Fortune Island Mines Ltd. acquired the property in April 1971 from principals of the company. During the year 6 additional claims (Kam 37-42) were staked and 6 silt samples collected.
