HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located south of the Osilinka River, approximately 40 miles northwest of Germansen Landing.

The Dove group, about 250 claims, was held in 1970 by Union Miniere Explorations and Mining Corporation Limited. Work included geological mapping and a geochemical soil and silt survey (1,122 samples).

The company held the ND 1-8 claims in this vicinity in 1974. Geological mapping was reported. During 1975 a geochemical soil survey was carried out over ND 1-8. Further geochemical work comprising 89 soil and 16 rock samples was carried out over ND 1, 2, 4, 7 in 1976.
