DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Tenakihi Group (Proterozoic) quartz-muscovite schist is intruded by felsite. Small veins in the quartzite and schist contain galena, tetrahedrite, and ruby silver. A grab sample assayed 5.4 ounces silver per ton, 0.38% copper, 3.15% zinc, 1.39% lead, and 0.007 ounce gold per ton.

The property is located on the south side of the Swannell River 10 miles northeast of Aiken Lake.

The Nel 1-48 claims were owned in 1973 by D. Reinke. Work on the property, carried out under the name Interior Syndicate, included geological mapping and a geochemical soil survey of 56 samples.
