DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A single piece of float, about 5 inches in diameter and comprising nearly solid bornite, was found on the valley floor about 1½ miles southeast of Dewar Peak. In addition to copper it contained 0.005 ounce gold and 4.56 ounces of silver a ton. (Lord, C.S., 1948).

"Takla Group flows, agglomerates, tuffs, limestone, argillite, gneiss, and conglomerate underlie most of the claims, and are in fault contact with the Asitka Group to the northeast. The Takla rocks have been disrupted by block faulting and intruded by dykes of quartz-feldspar porphyry. Malachite, chalcopryrite, minor chalcocite, and traces of bornite occur in quartz and calcite veinlets along faults or shear zones and adjacent to porphyry dykes." (G.E.M., 1973).

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

Dewar Peak lies about 12 miles southeast of Thutade Lake. The mineralized float was found near the headwaters of Moosevale Creek some 2½ miles southeast of Dewar Peak.

Dorita Silver Mines Ltd. in April 1973 optioned 142 claims in the Barn, Bear, Ice, Niven, Pike and Sno groups from M. Bratlin and T.H. Cross. Geological mapping and a geochemical soil and silt survey (526 samples) were carried out. The option was subsequently abandoned.
