DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Country rocks include Hazelton Group tuff and agglomerate units cut by porphyry dykes. Mineralization consists of disseminated bornite and chalcopyrite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,500 feet elevation between Two Lake and Red Creeks 11 miles west-southwest of Sustut Peak.

The Mac, Grizzly, and Bird groups were owned by Wesfrob Mines Limited in 1973. Work included trenching on Mac 185 and 156 feet of diamond drilling in 6 holes on Grizzly 1, 2 and Mac 183, 185.
