DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by andesite and andesitic tuff. Pyrite, minor chalcopyrite, sphalerite, and galena have been observed.

Associated minerals or products of value - Lead, zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 4½ miles north of the junction of Red Creek and the Sustut River, at approximately 5,000 feet elevation.

The Bird group of claims was held by Wesfrob Mines Limited in 1973. Work included electromagnetic and magnetometer surveys over 1.8 line-miles, a self potential survey over 1.7 line-miles, a geochemical soil survey (170 samples), and trenching.
