DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by porphyry and stratabound copper mineralization which occurs in Takla Group pyroclastic units.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations of 3,500 to 5,500 feet on the west side of the Sustut River 8 miles southwest of Sustut Peak.

McIntyre Porcupine Mines Limited in 1973 held the Roy group of some 250 claims.

Work included geological mapping, a geochemical soil and silt survey comprising about 1,200 samples, and trenching on Roy 153 and 154.
