DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Fine-grained chalcocite with some bornite and chalcopyrite occurs in the upper part of the Lower Takla Group volcanic rocks close to its contact with Upper Takla units.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 6 miles west of Sustut Peak on a major southerly flowing tributary of Two Lake Creek.

Consolidated Standard Mines Limited and Yukon Gold Placers, Limited held the No. 1 - 1 to 20, No. 2 - 1 to 20, and A 1 to 64 claims in 1973. Work included geological mapping, a geochemical survey comprising 212 silt, 14 soil, and 10 rock samples, and 1,000 feet of diamond drilling in 2 holes on No. 2 - 5 and 20.
