DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Takla Group volcanic rocks consisting mainly of an ash flow unit and a volcanoclastic unit contain chalcopyrite, bornite, and chalcocite which occur along fractures, as disseminations, and as veins in shear zones.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the headwaters of Moosevale Creek, 6.5 miles west-northwest of Sustut Peak, at approximately 4,000 feet elevation.

By an agreement dated March 1973 Bow River Resources Ltd. optioned the B 1-36 claims from J.W. McLeod and J. Forster of Vancouver. Work during the year was carried out by Brascan Resources Limited and included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 19 line-miles, and a geochemical survey comprising 970 soil and 49 silt samples.
