Takla Group volcanic rocks consisting mainly of an ash flow unit and a volcaniclastic unit contain chalcopyrite, bornite, and chalcocite which occur along fractures, as disseminations, and as veins in shear zones.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the headwaters of Moosevale Creek, 6.5 miles west-northwest of Sustut Peak, at approximately 4,000 feet elevation.

By an agreement dated March 1973 Bow River Resources Ltd. optioned the B 1-36 claims from J.W. McLeod and J. Forster of Vancouver. Work during the year was carried out by Brascan Resources Limited and included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 19 line-miles, and a geochemical survey comprising 970 soil and 49 silt samples.
