DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showings are exposed in a canyon about 160 feet deep in medium-to-coarse-grained, pink biotite granodiorite of the Omineca batholith. A rusty area, shaped like an inverted triangle, lies with its apex 80 feet above the creek and extends up the slope so that its base, about 30 feet wide, lies close to the lip of the canyon. Fractured granodiorite within this area is cut by a network of white quartz veinlets. The quartz contains many open cavities lined with quartz crystals as much as 2 inches long, fragments of bleached granodiorite containing a little fine-grained pyrite, and scattered pockets of coarse-grained pale pyrite up to 3 inches or more in diameter. A selected sample of quartz, coarse-grained pyrite, and bleached pyritized granodiorite assayed: gold, trace; silver, 0.09 ounce a ton. A selected sample of granodiorite with a little chalcopyrite, from the talus below the mineralized area, assayed: gold, 0.0025 ounce a ton; silver, 0.05 ounce a ton. Other rusty areas were seen on the canyon walls in the vicinity.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This occurrence is located in a canyon about 1,000 feet up a tributary stream from the west wall of McConnell Creek valley, 1 mile south of the south end of McConnell Lakes.

The King George group was held by P. Jenson & associates, of Hazelton in 1932. Little or no work has been done on this property.
