Chalcopyrite and pyrite occur in sheared volcanic rocks of the Takla Group near a small granodiorite intrusion.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 feet elevation in the Ingenika River valley, 15 miles north of Sustut Lake.

The Nikos 1-36 claims were held during 1973-1974 by Utah Mines Ltd. During 1973 geological mapping, a reconnaissance magnetometer survey over 4 line-miles, and a geochemical survey comprising 100 soil and 10 silt samples was carried out over 5 line-miles. In 1974 a further geochemical soil survey (360 samples) was carried out over 17 line-miles covering all claims.
