DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Irregular chalcopyrite stringers and blebs in a specularite-quartz, and locally calcite gangue in veins up to 1' in width. Veins are fracture-controlled and occur in Takla volcanics, andesite, being most common rock type locally. Kastberg intrusions two miles to the south.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 4 miles west of Bear Lake at an elevation of 5,000'.

Cominco Ltd. held the Dave 1-8 claims in 1968; the claims were in part a restaking of the former Bobnx, and Bearnx (94 D/2, Cu 2) groups. Work during the year included an electromagnetic survey over 2.8 line-miles.

The Drift 1-22 claims in this vicinity were held in 1974 by Canadian Nickel Company Limited. Geological mapping was reported.
