DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The plains are underlain mainly by Takla Group andesite tuff and coarse agglomerate. Transecting shear zones contain disseminated chalcocite, bornite, and chalcopyrite and rarely lenses of massive sulphides.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,500 feet elevation 4 miles east of the Sustut River and 7 miles southwest of Sustut Peak.

Wesfrob Mines Limited held the Pluto 1-6 claims in 1973. A geochemical survey of 97 talus fines samples was taken on random traverses.
