DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by an Early Mesozoic sequence of pyroclastic, volcanic-derived sedimentary rocks. Mineralization consists of disseminated chalcocite in andesitic tuffs and dacite of the Takla Group.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles east of Mount Carruthers, Sikanni Range, between 5,600 and 6,000 feet elevation.

The Pad 1-12 claims were held during 1973-1974 by S.E.R.E.M. Ltd. Work included geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey (139 samples), and 1,052 feet of diamond drilling in 5 holes on Pad 11 and 12.
