Bornite, chalcocite, and chalcopyrite occur in quartz-filled fractures. The underlying rock is a massive, conformable sequence of porphyritic andesitic flows and pyroclastic rocks of the Takla group.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located south of the Chukachida River, a tributary of the Stikine River, near Moosehorn Lake.

The showings were discovered by Canadian Superior Exploration Limited in 1964 and 52 claims were staked. Exploration of the showings was a joint venture by the above company along with Canadian Exploration Limited and Asbestos Corporation Limited. Two months work was done in geological mapping, sampling, and trenching. Seven trenches of a total length of 344 feet were made by blasting.

The Claw 1-64 claims in this vicinity were held in 1973-1974 by Union Minière Explorations and Mining Corporation Limited. Exploration work included geological mapping, geochemical soil surveys (264 samples), a ground magnetometer survey over 3.84 line-miles, and 587 feet of diamond drilling in 2 holes on Claw 5.
