## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by massive and porphyritic andesite and basalt flows of the Takla Group. A felsite sill intrudes the massive lava, and the porphyritic lava is cut by a quartz-carbonate vein carrying sporadic galena, sphalerite, pyrite, and chalcopyrite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc, copper.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 2 miles southeast of the junction of Moosehorn and Hiamadam Creeks and 8 miles southwest of Chukachida Lake.

The Har 1-6 claims were owned by Kennco Explorations, (Western) Limited. During 1973 Conwest Exploration Company Limited carried out a geochemical silt, soil, and talus fines survey (122 samples) covering all claims.
