DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Quartz monzonite and quartz feldspar porphyry have intruded andesite and rhyolite flows of the Takla Group. An alteration zone occurring within the intrusives and the country volcanic rocks appears silicified and rich in pyrite. Minor chalcopyrite is found in calcite veins which cut the intrusive.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
The property is located at about the 5,000 foot eleva-

tion at the south end of Duncan Lake, 4 miles east of Thutade Lake.

Cominco Ltd. acquired the Rat 1-26 claims in about 1968. Work during 1970 included a geochemical soil survey over Rat 7-10 and Rat 1 Fraction, and diamond drilling in 1 hole totalling 287 feet on Rat 17.

In 1974 the Rat 6-10, 15, 17, 19, DL 1-26, and DL 15 Fraction were owned by Cominco Ltd. and Craigmont Mines Limited. Work by Craigmont during the year included an induced potential survey over 10 line-miles.
