## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite, molybdenite, sphalerite, and magnetite occur in several small skarn zones within coarsely recrystallized limestone re-entrants or roof pendants in a medium-grained granodiorite.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 feet elevation on the northwest side of the Findlay River 6 miles north of Thutade Lake.

The Vip 1-40 claims were held in 1974 by Amax Exploration, Inc. Geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 14 line-miles, and a geochemical soil survey (364 samples) were carried out.
