HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The ED 1-14 claims were acquired for staking costs by Red Rock Mines Ltd. in 1969. A magnetometer survey was carried out during the year. The claims were overstaked by the Belle claims. The company name was changed in 1970 to Alakon Metals Ltd.
