DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by a thick sequence of greenish and purplish andesitic flows, cherty andesites, and porphyritic andesitic pyroclastic rocks, possibly part of the upper division of the Takla Group. Lead, zinc, and copper mineralization is found in small, discontinuous quartz and/or quartz-carbonate veins and veinlets in fault zones or at geological contacts.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc, copper.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 6,500 feet elevation on the west side of Mulvaney Creek, 8 miles south of Chukachida Lake.

The Gord 1-46 claims were held in 1974 by Union Miniere Explorations and Mining Corporation Limited. Geological mapping, an electromagnetic survey over 6.9 line-miles, and a geochemical soil survey (293 samples) over 10.7 line-miles were carried out.
