The property is located at approximately 6,500 feet elevation east of Cranswick Lake at the head of Trimble Creek, some 39 miles west of the Alaska Highway, at Sikanni Chief.

Canadian Superior Exploration Limited held the Lynda 1-60 claims in 1973. A geochemical rock survey (144 samples) was carried out.
