DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is underlain mainly by thick-bedded limestone, which is overlain to the northeast by thin-bedded limestone and interbedded limestone and shale. Traces of sphalerite occur in the thick-bedded limestone and traces of galena in quartz veins cutting the limestone.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Colledge Creek, six miles south of Redfern Lake.

The Boot 1-20 and Heel 1-20 claims were optioned from J.C. Needoba and R. Turner by Belmoral Mines Ltd. and Grandora Explorations Ltd. Work on the property in 1973 included geological mapping, and a geochemical soil survey (512 samples) covering all claims.
