HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located about 3 miles northwest of the junction of Delano Creek and the Racing River.

The Lemjay group of 6 claims was acquired in about 1965 by Churchill Copper Corporation Ltd. In 1966 Racing River Mines Ltd. staked the Paul, Moose, and Goat groups surrounding the Lemjay group. An electromagnetic survey was carried out by Racing River Mines in 1966.
