Galena and sphalerite occur in dolomite of Cambrian age and in argillite and quartzite of Precambrian age.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of 6,000 feet, 14 miles southwest of Tuchodi Lakes and 7 miles west of Tuchodi River.

The A 1-20 claims were held in 1972 by Cordero Mining Company, a subsidiary of Sun Oil Company. Geological mapping and a geochemical soil and stream sediment survey (79 samples) was carried out.
