## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The rocks exposed are mainly Proterozoic siltstone and shale cut by north-northwest striking diabase dykes. Two quartz-carbonate vein systems are exposed on strike about 5,000 feet apart. The showing on claim P75 is a 25 foot wide mineralized zone containing quartz-carbonate lenses one inch to one foot wide and up to 6 feet long. Chalcopyrite occurs as blebs erratically distributed in the lenses. Another showing is located on claim P 12.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the Gataga River some 8 miles southwest of Churchill Peak.

Fortune Channel Mines Ltd. and Beaumont Resources Limited acquired an option to purchase 53 claims in July 1970. Work during the year included geological mapping, trenching, and diamond drilling, under a joint venture agreement. Fortune Channel Mines changed its name in 1972 to Consolidated Fortune Channel Mines Ltd.
