DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Narrow lenses of pyrite, galena and sphalerite, and broad zones of disseminated pyrite occur in green schist facies metasedimentary rocks (micaceous and calcareous metaquartzites, interstratified with pelitic schists) subjacent to the Cassiar batholith.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This showing is located at the 5.800 foot elevation in a cirque at the headwaters of Hals Creek, 2.5 miles west of its confluence with the Frog River.

In 1959 the West Group of 32 recorded claims, owned by Nels Hall, was held under option by Conwest Exploration Company Limited. Trenching was done during the year to trace the galena float to its origin.

Conwest ran a geophysical survey of the West Group in 1963.

Resistivity and I.P. surveys were done in 1970 covering the Linda and West claims. Surface geological mapping covering approximately eight claims and 3,049 feet of surface diamond drilling on Linda 11 and 13 and West 3. 5 and 6 were also done.
