HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The Aird 1 to 20 claims are located one-half mile north of the north end of William Lake at 300 to 500-foot elevation.

In 1969 Utah Construction & Mining Co. mapped the claims topographically and geologically. Five hundred samples were taken over 18 line-miles during a geochemical soil survey.
