DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The occurrence is located in a wide belt of intercalated limestone and schist of Triassic age which, in turn, occurs as an inclusion in a granodiorite batholith. The bedding strikes E-W and dips S with the joint planes striking N-S. The inclusion is not of great thickness over the batholith. The mineralized areas occur as lenticular masses of pyrrhotite, pyrite, some zinc blende and minor chalcopyrite occurring along lines of schistosity and jointing. Locally, wall rocks show some iron sulphide impregnation.

Samples assayed as follows:-

- 1) massive sulphides - 0.02 oz. gold per ton, 0.4 oz. silver per ton, trace copper.
- 2) schistose wall rock - 0.04 oz. gold per ton, 0.28 oz. silver per ton, trace copper.

Associated minerals or products of value - Silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The occurrence is located on the west shore of the head of the north arm of Neekas cove, Ellerslie channel in section 9, block 1.

The Moss and McKay claim was Crown-granted as Sec. 9, Blk. 1 to McKay and M. Moss on Oct. 20, 1882. No work was reported.

In 1931, W.A. Robbins obtained a lease and drove a 22 foot adit from the west bank, at the mouth of Neekas River.
