The property is believed to be underlain by the Karmutsen Formation, adjacent to the Louscoone fault zone. The mineralization is reported to include a copper showing, and a zinc showing which carries values in gold.

The showing is located between sea level and 1,000 feet elevation on the east end of Talunkwan Island.

The Hawks Nest group of 5 claims was owned by Messrs. Hemming and Magee from about 1908. During 1909 the claims were surveyed and two adits driven. In 1911 the Blue Bell, Maud, Lilly, Anney Fraction, and Hawk's Nest Fraction (Lots 135-139, respectively) were Crown-granted to Elizabeth A.O. Hemming.
