DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The showing occurs as a replacement zone on a limestone-volcanic contact of the Karmutsen Formation. An exposure of two feet of chalcopyrite was found near the lime. Some copper-pyrites occur in the diabase rock.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showing is located at sea level on the east side of High Island, just to the northeast of Kunghit Island. The property was owned by J. Uniaka in 1913; no exploration work was reported.

In 1931 some stripping and open cutting was reported to have been carried out.
