The Triassic and Jurassic Kunga Formation is exposed on the east side of Frederick Island and on Kennecott Point on the west side of Graham Island. The Formation locally contains an oil shale.

Frederick Island is located on the west side of Graham Island, Queen Charlotte Islands.

Skaist Mines Ltd. by a November 1974 option agreement acquired a 70% interest in the OS 1-6 claims, which were optioned from Toni Holdings & Management Ltd., owned by Dieter Ludwig and Susanne Robertson of Vancouver, and the Hanovarian Syndicate, owned by Hans Buhr & associates of Vancouver.
