DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The deposit is a metasomatic replacement with minor blobs of iron sulphides with some stibnite (?) in a host of gneissic quartz diorite.

A sample, which was shipped to the Provincial Government Sampling Plant at Prince Rupert in 1942, assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 0.56 ounce per ton; lead, 0.1%; zinc, 0.2%; antimony, 32.9 per cent.
