This group is situated about 2½ miles north-northeast of the point where Douglas Channel meets the north shore of Kitkiata Inlet, at an approximate elevation of 550 feet.

The Decaire group of 4 claims was owned in 1929-1930 by Messrs. Decaire, Venanzio, and associates. During that period the showing was opened by two small cuts and traced for about 60 feet.
