The property is located 2 miles due east of Lower Lake, near the big bend in the Ecstall River.

In 1968, Texas Gulf Sulfur Company owned the Horsefly 1-6 claims. During that year on an area 1,000 feet by 1,000 feet, the company completed detailed geological mapping, a magnetometer survey, and an electromagnetic (E.M.) survey.

During the course of the following season, Texas Gulf maintained the claims in good standing by completing more geophysical surveying.

The company changed its name to Texas Gulf, Inc., in 1972, and to Texasgulf Inc. in 1973.
